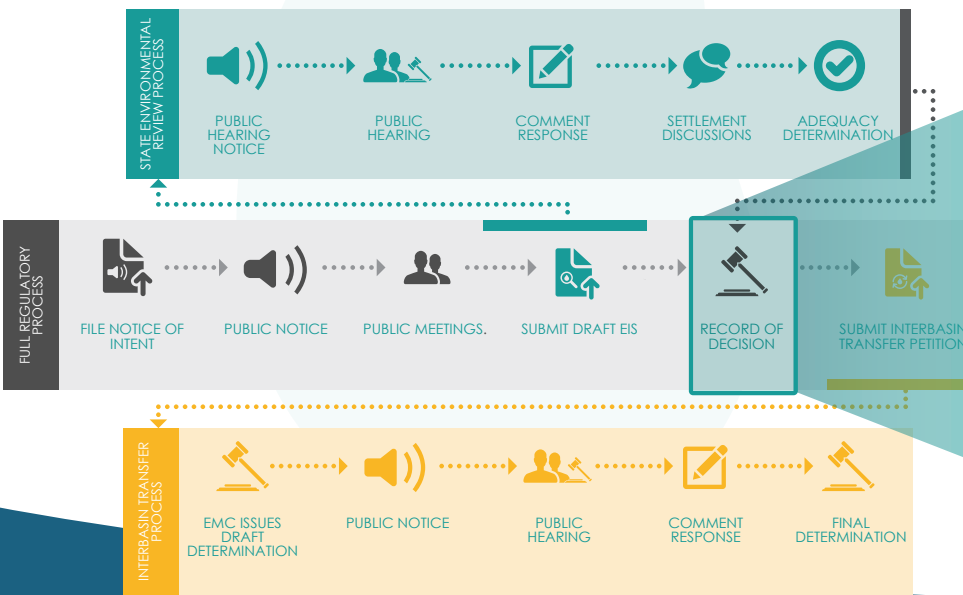

## What is the Yadkin Regional Water Supply Project?

The Yadkin Regional Water Supply project is a collaborative effort between Union County and the Town of Norwood to provide a new water supply source to Union County's Yadkin River Basin residents and new infrastructure to the Town of Norwood. This project will include a new water intake and pump station in Norwood to access Lake Tillery and a 21 mile pipeline to bring that water to Union County residents in the Yadkin River Basin.

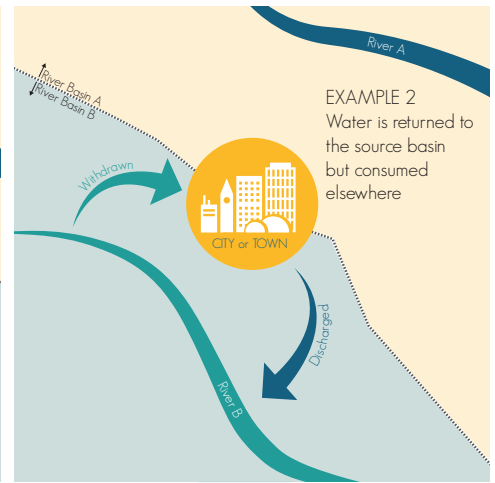
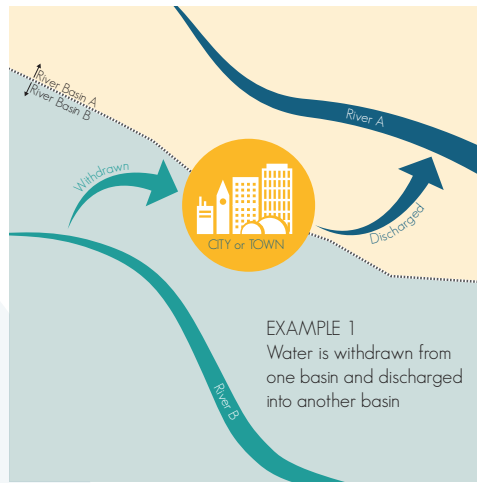

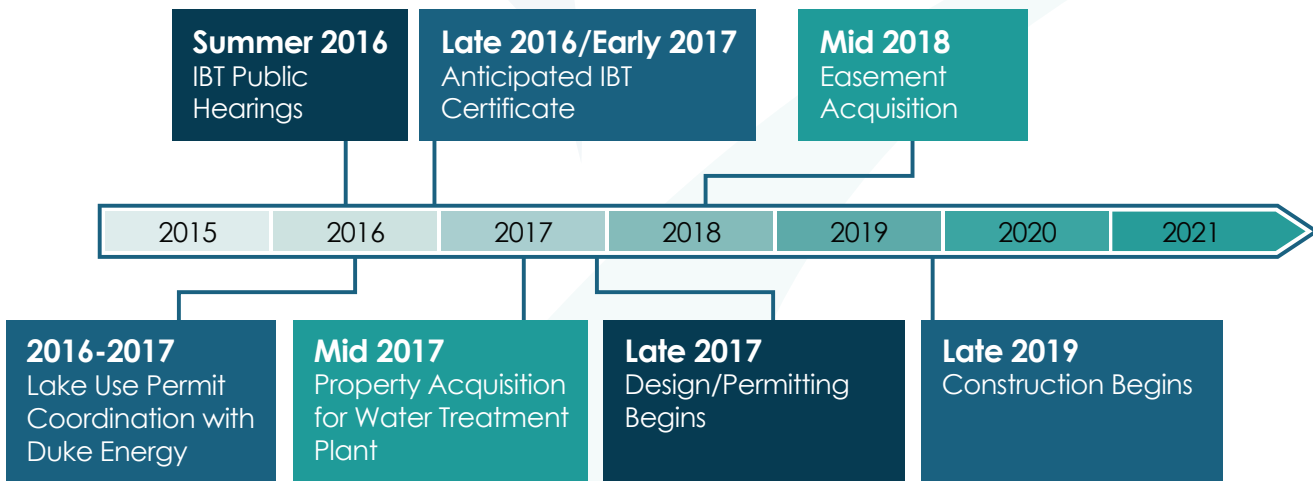

# What is Interbasin Transfer?

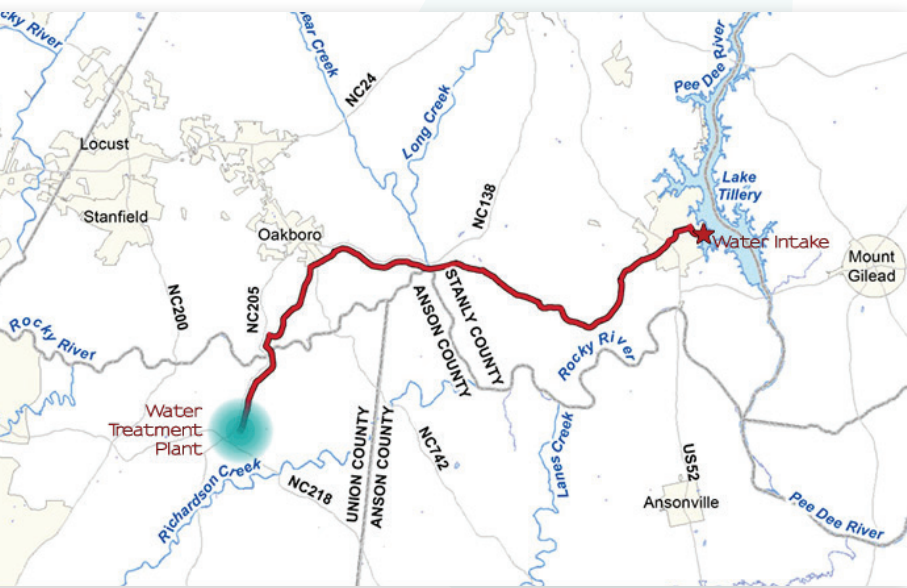
An interbasin transfer or IBT is the movement of surface water from one river basin into another. Transfers that exceed a 2 million gallons per day average daily, or 3 million gallons per day maximum daily, require an IBT certificate and approval from the North Carolina Environmental Management Commission (EMC).
